- 2. Recently, a new interface was established between the Office of Logistics (OL) and the Far East (FE) Division, DD/P, to facilitate the exchange of information and promote a better and more complete understanding of logistical requirements and their satisfaction. This lisison has provided OL with ready access to the FE Situation Room and has made available both routine communications and significant papers budget. A senior member of the Planning Staff, such as the FY 67 OL, meets weekly with the Chief of Support, FE. Both FE Division and this Office have materially benefited through this management technique.
