1. This memorandum is for your information only.

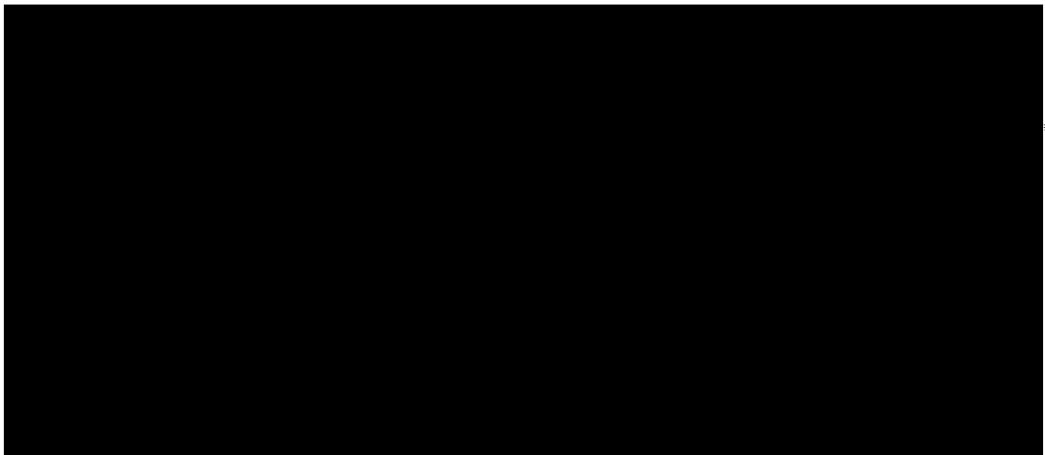
2. Recently, a new interface was established between the Office of Logistics (OL) and the Far East (FE) Division, DE/P, to facilitate the exchange of information and promote a better and more complete understanding of logistical requirements and their satisfaction. This liaison has provided OL with ready access to the FE Situation Room and has made available both routine communications and significant papers such as the FY 67 [redacted] budget. A senior member of the Planning Staff, OL, meets weekly with the Chief of Support, FE. Both FE Division and this Office have materially benefited through this management technique.

3. [redacted] was selected as the first example of an FE project necessitating significant logistics support to be thoroughly reviewed and analyzed with this new concept. While it was known that [redacted] was underbudgeted in FY 67, our joint review with FE has produced a more accurate and timely estimate of the true deficit for logistics support. In analyzing the known and predicted rates of issue and consumption, compared to the current budget authorizations and proposed expenditures, the following facts emerged:

4. This interface and planning effort with the FE Division personnel established that the list of requirements and the prices used in the original computation required adjustment. The revised

5. As a result of the above analysis and findings, the FE Division withdrew and revised the [REDACTED] supplemental budget request in order to reflect the new funding need for logistics support. FE has advised OL that the Bureau of the Budget (BOB) hearing on [REDACTED] was held on 22 September 1966 and the BOB was informed of the additional funds required. At the present time, a decision is pending in the Office of Planning, Programming and Budgeting (OPPB) on the method of providing the additional funds, either through a release from Agency reserve or from a supplemental budget request. Either method should provide adequate funds and ERA for [REDACTED]. If the decision is made to seek these funds from a supplemental budget request they probably will not be available until January or February 1967. However, if the supplemental funds are not made available, this Office has no alternative but to suspend issuances when the available funds are expended.
