REFERENCE : Memorandum for DCI from DD/P dated 1 April 1960 recommending contract employment at a salary of \$14,500 per annum for Mr. [redacted]. (HR-60-2488)

1. This memorandum contains a recommendation for DCI approval. Said recommendation is set forth in paragraph 5 below.

2. Mr. [redacted] was converted from staff to contract employee status on 5 June 1960 to serve with [redacted]. Your approval of reference authorized a contract salary of \$14,500 per annum.

3. Prior to his conversion, Mr. [redacted] was earning \$13,670 per annum as a staff employee. Thus, his contract salary provided an increase of \$830 per annum over his staff salary. This salary was considered commensurate with his responsibilities and compatible with other [redacted] salaries. Interestingly enough, had Mr. [redacted] retained his staff position with the Agency, he now would be earning \$14,705 per annum as a result of the legislative salary increase for Government employees effective in July of 1960. A salary increase for Mr. [redacted] was not proposed under that legislation because of a desire to keep his salary compatible with those of [redacted].
