In response to your instructions of 18 February, informal discussions with many of the military participants in Project revealed a concensus that: A two-day course was adequate for this type of group; individual presentations were fine; there was no feelingithat presenters were deliberately withholding information the group should have received; the course was very worthwhile; all appreciated the efforts of the Agency on their behalf.
- 3. The following isolated comments should be considered in preparing for subsequent presentations of Project 25X1A2g
 - a. One speaker did not allow time for a question-answer period. All those contacted remarked that the opportunity to pose questions was particularly valuable.
 - b. For one totally unfamiliar with intelligence operations at the Washington level, data were presented too rapidly.
