In response to your instructions of 18 February, informal discussions with many of the military participants in Project [REDACTED] revealed a consensus that: A two-day course was adequate for this type of group; individual presentations were fine; there was no feeling that presenters were deliberately withholding information the group should have received; the course was very worthwhile; all appreciated the efforts of the Agency on their behalf.
