- 1. I have instructed o revise his description of the "two-day" package to emphasize "countermeasures." I have told him that he should explain the need for the inclusion of positive audio operational information in the introduction. This can be done by emphasizing the fact that 90% of finds have been through visual, physical search; therefore, it follows that the more you know of the mentality and modus operandi of the positive operator, the more likely the finding of the plants. If we create a real awareness of the audio threat, we will have presented a successful package.
- 2. The photo lab will be open from 1800 to 2100 hours in order that those who feel the need to brush up may do so. This is a facility which should be as accessible as the language lab, and its availability should assure a greater competency in JOT graduates, provided they make use of it.

involved.


