SUBJECT: Utilization of Unvouchered Funds for Tuition

DATE: 20 May 1949

1. It is requested that we be authorized \$450.00 from unvouchered funds to pay tuition for a course of training in use of the Polygraph.

2. This course which is taken under the auspices of the Chicago Police Department, Chicago, Illinois, requires six weeks of study and training. [REDACTED] entered on this course of study 18 April 1949 and the course will be completed 28 May 1949. [REDACTED] will be charged with the responsibility of maintaining an uninterrupted operation of the Polygraph.

3. This request is made in connection with the project outlined in your memorandum to all Assistant Directors, dated 23 August 1948, subject: "Study Project on Technical Investigative Methods in Time of Emergency."
