My dear Mr. Hoover:

It is understood that representatives of our respective offices have reached a verbal understanding that the Federal Bureau of Investigation will conduct security investigations of employees of the Central Intelligence Group on a reimbursable basis. It is further understood that the bureau will be reimbursed at the rate of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per case.

The above agreement is satisfactory and your confirmation is requested.

I wish you would designate a representative of your office to meet with my representative, [redacted] to work out the detailed procedures to be followed. These details will include methods of reimbursement, procedure for referring cases, standards desired, and similar administrative problems.
