Dear Mr. Elattenbergers

In accordance with my letter to you dated July 4, 1956, and your reply thereto dated July 9, 1956, representatives of the Government Frinting Office and the Central Intelligence Agency have theroughly discussed the proposed transfer to the Central Intelligence Agency of the Government Frinting Office printing plant located in this Agency's Administration Building. General agreement has been reached and the following is therefore proposed for your concurrence and the approval of the Joint Committee on Frinting:

- a. Effective January 1, 1957, the Government Printing Office printing plant located at 2430 B Street, M. W., Washington, D. C., shall be transferred to and operated by the Central Intelligence Agency under the authority of Section 10(a)(1) of Public Law 110, Slat Congress.
- b. All printing equipment now in the plant which the Government Printing Office obtained from the predecessor operators of the plant shall be transferred to the Central Intelligence Agency without reinbursement therefor. A list of such equipment has been jointly prepared and is attached hereto as Annex A.
- e. All printing equipment now in the plant which was purchased by the Central Intelligence Agency subsequent to assumption of administrative control of the plant by the Coverment Printing

Office shall be transferred to the Central Intelligence Agency without reinbursement therefor. A list of such equipment has been jointly prepared and is attached hereto as amon B.

- d. All other printing equipment now in the plant which has been procured by the Government frinting Office shall be transferred to the Central Intelligence Agency and the Central Intelligence Agency shall reimbures the Government Frinting Office in the ascent representing the cost to the Government Frinting Office lass depreciation to January 1, 1957. A list of such equipment showing the reimburement price of each place of equipment has been jointly prepared and is attached bareto as Annex C.
- e. All supplies, replacement parts, etc. (except those furnished by the Central Intelligence Agency), which the plant may have on hand or on order as of the effective date of the transfer shall be acquired by the Central Intelligence Agency at a price representing cost to the Government Printing Office.
- f. The Central Intelligence agency shall provide classified printing at cost to the Atomic Energy Coumission, the State Department, and any other agancy which berstofore has used the subject plent for classified printing to the extent that such service may have been previously furnished by the Government Frinting Office. The Atomio Shergy Commission and the State Department have been apprised of this proposed transfer and have interposed no objection thereto. The subject printing plant shall not perform any uncleasified printing for the Central Istelligence agency or for any other Coverment Lemay, except upon weiver issued by the Covernment Printing Office, while operating in its present location. When the plant is merged with the Central Intelligence Agency's facilities in a single location no unclassified printing shall be performed by this printing plant except that type of printing which would normally be produced in a Government duplicating plant.

- to these Covernment Printing Office employees presently employed in the plant the opportunity of transferring to and becoming employees of the Control Intallignose Agency.
- h. The Government Printing Office shall retain on its rolls as its employees those personnal electing not to transfer to the Central Intelligence ignory, except that personnal on the rolls of the plant shan shainistrative control was assumed by the Government Printing Office on February 1, 1947, or requited subsequent to that date for specific emigraent to the plant of the Covernment Printing Office. Irrior to the effective date of this transfer the Covernment Printing Office and the Control Intelligence ignor ignory shall jointly propers a list of personnal desiring to transfer to the Control Intelligence.
- appensible for obtaining personnel to replace these Government Printing Office exployees who may elect not to transfer to and become exployees of the Central Intelligence Agency. However, the Constraining Office will, on requisition by the Central Intelligence Agency, detail for a period not to unneed six months and at their prevailing salmy, suck personnel as may be required until replacement personnel can be recruited, cleared, and contered on duty.
- 1. Upon the effective date of this transfer the Central Intelligence agency shell have cralusive operating control of the printing plant.
- k. The Central Intelligence /gency shall be responsible for obtaining agreement with the Atomic Energy Consission regarding electrons of Central Intelligence Agency personnal assigned to to the atomic Energy Consission's classified printing referred to in paragraph f. above.

This famility will therefore be available to the Government Printing Office for printing highly classified work for which your main plant may not be equipped. Further, this agency intends to continue to rely on the Government Printing Office for its unclessified printing and for paper and supplies used in our printing facilities.
