As requested, following is a report of significant activities for this office for the preceding week.

1. Director of Medical Services met on 23 September with a consultant to the Murphy Commission, Alex George, Ph.D. This was at the request of the Intelligence Community Staff and a separate report (with copy to DDA) has been submitted to the ICS on this meeting. Dr. George, for the Commission, is interested in the relationship of stress to irrational thinking in foreign policy decision making.

2. Deputy Director of Medical Services visited [redacted] 23 September to review the medical support aspects of a DDS&T special project.

3. 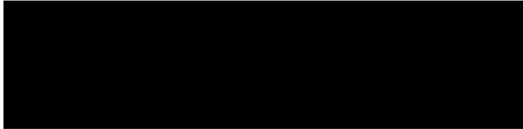
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
