TO THE HEADS OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND ESTABLISHMENTS

SUBJECT: Amendment to Standardized Government Travel Regulations

The last sentence of section 6.11 of the regulations, revised June 22, 1956, as amended effective August 1, 1959, is amended effective this date to read:

"For continuous travel of 24 hours or less, the travel period will be regarded as commencing with the beginning of the travel and ending with its completion, and for each 6-hour portion of the period, or fraction of such portion, one-fourth of the per diem for a calendar day will be allowed: Provided, That no per diem will be allowed when the travel period is 10 hours or less during the same calendar day, except when the travel period is 6 hours or more and begins before 6:00 a.m. or terminates after 8:00 p.m. (See sections 6.9a and c.)"
