It was [redacted] intent, when Travel Order [redacted] was issued, to authorize the maximum allowable under Regulation [redacted] whatever that maximum might be. On our assumption that the Regulation limited the maximum weight allowable from an overseas point to that authorized for shipment to such post, the figure of 4500 pounds was specified. However, since it was not the intent of [redacted] to deny Mr. [redacted] an allowance to which he was legally entitled, it is requested that this matter be reconsidered in the light of the General Counsel's interpretation as outlined in reference b.
