[REDACTED] and others of OTR attended the showing of a film, "The Village Which Refused to Die," in a U.S. Army projection room in the Pentagon. The showing was arranged by Major [REDACTED] of General [REDACTED]'s office. The film, which was made by a cameraman of a commercial TV station in Sacramento, California, portrays the continuing battle of the inhabitants of Binh Hung village in South Vietnam against the communist Viet Cong guerrillas. Mr. [REDACTED] pointed out that while the film has certain weaknesses, it would have definite value for training in Counter-Insurgency, particularly since it captures on the screen the grim realities of current anti-guerrilla operations in Southeast Asia. Mr. [REDACTED] suggested to Mr. [REDACTED] of Graphics Registry, who also attended the showing, that an Agency copy of the film be obtained.
