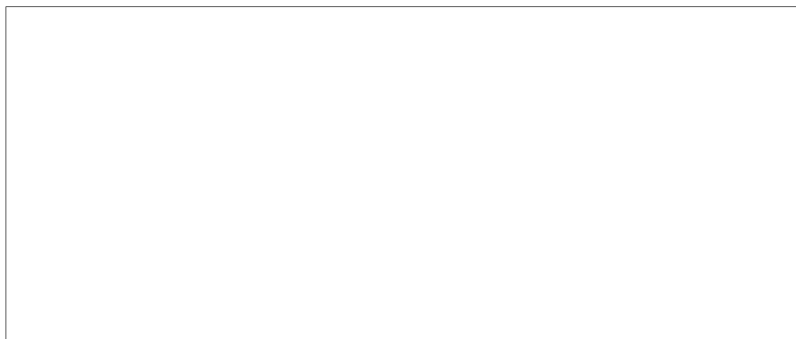

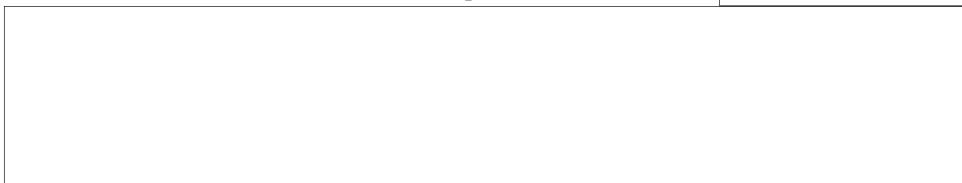

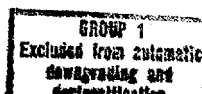

2. Dr. Frith, FSI, alerted us this week that the following language courses, scheduled to begin on 28 February, will probably be canceled due to lack of enrollments:

[redacted] We have checked with FE; there are no candidates for [redacted] however, the Division had planned to submit two training requests for [redacted] We informed Dr. Frith of this, mentioning that the training is only in the planning stage and may not be approved. Dr. Frith will hold off on cancelling this course until he hears further from us.

3. We are sending 14 nominations (4 - DDS&T, 4 - DDI, 6 - DDS) to CSC for the Middle Management Institute, 17 - 21 January. Mr. William Medina feels certain they will be able to accommodate our requests.

4. On 11 August OTR approved a full-time training program for [redacted] FE, stationed in Saigon. [redacted] training plan called for special study on the [redacted]

[redacted] He planned to apply at Harvard and/or MIT's Center for International Studies.

Yesterday [redacted] said that FE has just received a dispatch from Saigon, requesting an approval of [redacted] tour extension until May 1966. The dispatch also stated that he has been corresponding with three universities -- Cornell, Yale, and MIT -- and will keep Headquarters informed on his final decision. FE has approved his extension in Saigon.

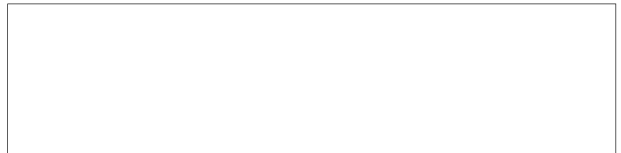
