1. Career Training Program

In a recent meeting of the DDP's Career Trainee Selection Board, it was determined that the Operations Course would be limited to DDP CTs only. Heretofore, certain DDS and DDI CTs could take the Ops Course on a need-to-know basis.

2. DDS and DDI Career Training Courses

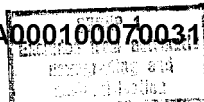

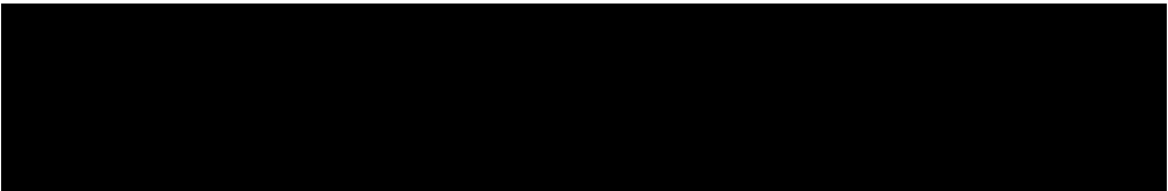
6. Seminar in Planning, Programming and Budgeting

For example, the participants responded as follows when asked to comment on how well the role of CIA was presented in the course -- poor 2, good 17, very good 23, excellent 8; the Langley visit -- poor 2, good 24, excellent 20; panel at the NIS auditorium -- poor 1

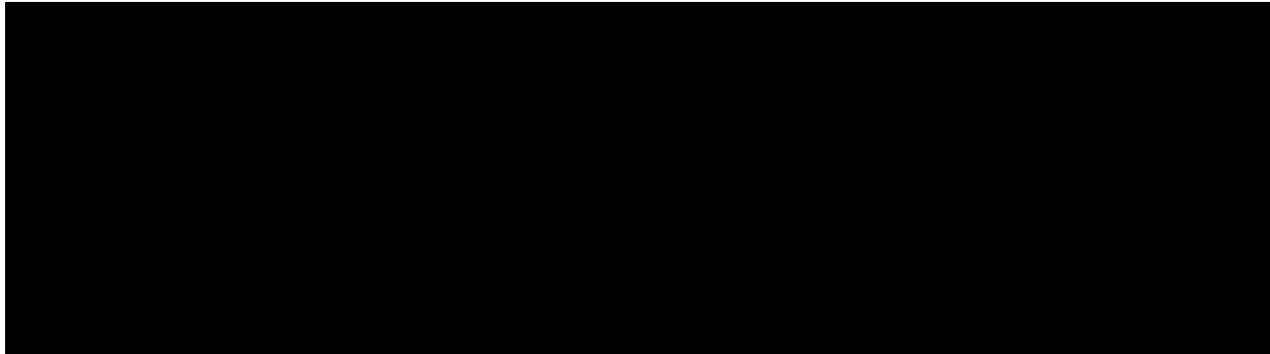
