To date this fiscal year we have sent (or enrolled) [Redacted] employees to the following FSI Area Studies: Africa, Sub-Sahara, People's Republic of China, East Asia, Eastern Europe and USSR, Latin America, Near East and North Africa, South Asia, and Southeast Asia. In addition, [Redacted] took an Area Study program as part of their language training (an FSI requirement for all language courses unless waived due to previous area knowledge and the like. We had two such waivers). Most of the Area Studies students attended overtly; enrollment was handled by OTR. [Redacted]

Tuition is presently \$497 for the two-week program. (It was \$489 in the first half of this FY.) To date our expenditure is \$16,738 for Area Studies alone, and an additional \$5,379 for the Area Studies/Language students. All FSI area and language training is now funded by the sponsoring component.
