MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD: (Excerpt from Weekly Activity Report No. 2 dtd 13 January 1967.

Attached is a copy of [redacted] report on his attendance at the Advanced Management Program at Harvard. In the oral briefing of members of the Registrar Staff, [redacted] mentioned Howard's concern over our "last minute" substitutions for each of the last two classes (Mike [redacted] for [redacted]

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[redacted] he was not aware of the most recent withdrawal (without substitution) of [redacted]...

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In the afternoon of 6 January 1967 we were informed by the Senior Training Officer, DDS&T, that [redacted] could not be spared from his assignment to attend the February Session of the Harvard Advanced Management Program. Exploring, on 9 January, the various facets of this sudden and unexpected development we learned that the decision to cancel [redacted] enrollment had been made on or about 3 January by the Executive Director in consultation with the Acting Deputy Director for Science and Technology. A phone call was made immediately to the Administrative Director of the Advanced Management Program, Graduate School of Business Administration, Harvard University, to give notification of the cancellation and to ascertain whether a substitution could be made. We were advised by Dean Van Gorder that a substitute nomination could not be accepted at this late date.

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The Office of the Deputy Director for Support was kept closely informed on the situation; we were notified by that office on 11 January that the decision to pull [redacted] out of the February running of the AMP was firm and final even though the Agency would not be allowed to propose an alternate candidate.

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
