MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD:

SUBJECT: The Brookings Conference for Federal Executives on Business Operations

The DDTR was notified yesterday, 1 December 1966, by the Executive Director-Comptroller that John Clarke, D/PPB, could not be spared, because of pressure of duties, to attend the Brookings Conference for Federal Executives on Business Operations scheduled to be held 4 - 9 December 1966 at Los Angeles and San Francisco. Colonel White informed us that he had already called Mr. Walter Held of Brookings to explain the situation and express regrets. Mr. Held was considerate and understanding and indicated that the Agency could provide a replacement for Mr. Clarke if we so desired. Inasmuch as Agency representation at this conference is considered desirable, OTR proposed that [REDACTED] 25X1A9a
