B. FICPAC MESSAGE DTG 090210Z, JAN. — NOT TO NPIC (NOTAL)
CONTINUING ANALYSIS BY NPIC OF MISSION BX6842 OF 4 JANUARY 1968 REVEALS THE REPORTED AREA IN REFERENCE AS A PROBABLE STATIC DISPLAY OF DOWNED U.S. AIRCRAFT. LOCATED ON THE FRINGES OF A MILITARY TRAINING AREA ASSOCIATED WITH BAC MA ARMY BARRACKS NE [redacted] 21 07 30N-106 29 57E). THE DISPLAY CAN PROBABLY BE USED AS A RECOGNITION TRAINING AID FOR ANTI-AIRCRAFT ARTILLERY GUNNERS OR FOR THE TRAINING OF PERSONNEL IN TECHNIQUES OF SABOTAGE/ASSAULT OF AIRFIELDS. THE AREA, LOCATED 19 NM NW OF HAI PHONG AT 21 06 45N-106 29 29E (UTM XJ548351), IS RECTANGULAR IN SHAPE AND CONSISTS OF 6 AIRCRAFT REVETMENTS, (2 DOUBLE REVETMENTS AND 2 SINGLE REVETMENTS 5 OF WHICH ARE OCCUPIED). THE SOUTHERN DOUBLE REVETMENT CONTAINS 1 POSSIBLE A-6 AIRCRAFT AND 1 POSSIBLE HELICOPTER FUSELAGE. THE SOUTHERN SINGLE REVETMENT CONTAINS A POSSIBLE PART OF AN AIRCRAFT FUSELAGE. THE NORTHERN DOUBLE REVETMENT CONTAINS 1 POSSIBLE F-5 TYPE AIRCRAFT AND THE NORTHERN SINGLE REVETMENT CONTAINS A POSSIBLE PART OF AN AIRCRAFT FUSELAGE. THE AREA DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE MISSILE ASSOCIATED.
