1. IMAGERY INTERPRETATION ANALYSTS REPRESENTING THE NPIC, CIA/IAS, DIA AND NRTSC CONVENED AT NPIC ON 1 FEBRUARY 1968 TO DISCUSS AND ESTABLISH A TARGET DESCRIPTION FOR THE SONGJON-PANDO NAVAL BASE AND MISSILE SUPPORT FACILITY, NORTH KOREA (39 22 08N-127 26 38E, AS A RESULT DIAAP-4A1 HAS TARGETED THIS INSTALLATION, AS TITLED ABOVE, FOR BOTH ACQUISITION AND REPORTING PURPOSES.

2. THE SONGJON-PANDO NAVAL BASE AND MISSILE SUPPORT FACILITY WAS DETERMINED TO ENCOMPASS THREE PREVIOUSLY TARGETED AREAS: MUNCHON NAVAL BASE NORTHEAST (SONGJON-MAN NAVAL BASE), 39 22 00N-127 27 15E; PANJA-RI NAVAL FACILITY, 39 22 08N-127 26 28E; AND, PANJA-RI NAVAL INSTALLATION, 39 21 45N-127 25 15E. ALTHOUGH THESE THREE INSTALLATIONS ARE NOT CONSIGUOUS, IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THEIR INTERRELATIONSHIP OF FUNCTION AS WELL AS CLOSE PROXIMITY OF THE INSTALLATIONS TO ONE ANOTHER DICTATED A SINGLE TARGET NAME WITH THE COMPONENTS OF EACH DESCRIBED AS TO FUNCTION WITHIN THE MAIN COMPLEX.

3. THE THREE AREAS COMPRISING THE SONGJON-PANDO NAVAL BASE AND MISSILE SUPPORT FACILITY ARE: THE OPERATING AREA, FORMERLY DESIGNATED MUNCHON NAVAL BASE NORTHEAST, WHICH HAS A FINGER PIER AND SUPPORT BUILDINGS ADEQUATE TO SUPPORT A PATROL BOAT SQUADRON; THE UNDERGROUND PATROL BOAT PEN, FORMERLY PANJA-RI NAVAL FACILITY, WHICH IS COMPRISED OF A WATER LEVEL TUNNEL, AND PROBABLE MISSILE CHECKOUT/LOADING FACILITIES FOR THE SSN-2 MISSILE; AND A NAVAL MISSILE STORAGE AREA, FORMERLY THE PANJA-RI NAVAL INSTALLATION WHICH PROVIDES STORAGE FOR CRATED SSN-2 MISSILES.

4. HISTORICAL REVIEW OF AVAILABLE PHOTOGRAPHY INDICATES THAT CONSTRUCTION OF THE UNDERGROUND PATROL BOAT PEN, THE NAVAL MISSILE STORAGE AND THE TUNNELS AT THE OPERATING AREA BEGAN IN 1962 AND PROCEEDED CONCURRENTLY, APPARENTLY REACHING OPERATIONAL STATUS DURING 1967.

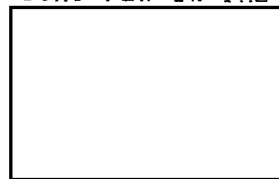
5. KOMAR PTG WERE BASED AT THE MUNCHON NAVAL BASE WONSAN (39 18 19N-127 23 54E) AS EARLY AS JUNE 1965. [Redacted] ALSO REVEALED A PROBABLE KOMAR PTG STERN-TO ADJACENT TO THE WATER LEVEL ENTRANCE AT THE SONGJON-PANDO UNDERGROUND PATROL BOAT PEN IN THE

6. THE NKN ACQUISITION OF AT LEAST 7 KOMAR PTG (4 OF WHICH WERE OBSERVED AS EARLY AS SUMMER 1965) SUGGEST THAT SONGJON-PANDO NAVAL BASE WAS CONSTRUCTED AS A KOMAR PTG BASE.

7. HENCEFORTH THE NPIC WILL REPORT THESE INSTALLATIONS UNDER THE NAME, COORDINATES AND BE NUMBER AS CITED IN PARAGRAPH ONE ABOVE.
