

PRELIMINARY SCAN OF BRASS KNOB MISSION 3444, DATED 23
FEBRUARY 1963, REVEALS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE PORTS
LISTED BELOW:

HAVANA (1610Z) -- DUE TO HAZE AND CLOUD COVER ONLY THE
KIMOVSK, 2 LGOV-CLASS AND PROBABLE ORENBERG WERE IDENTIFIED IN
HAVANA HARBOR. KIMOVSK HAS THREE HATCHES OPEN, ONE LIGHTER AND
TWO SMALL CRAFT ALONGSIDE. TWO LGOV-CLASS AT PIERS, ONE ON SOUTH
SIDE OF MACHINA PIER HAS ONE POSSIBLE OPEN HATCH AND TWO BOOMS
OVER THE SIDE, SECOND LGOV-CLASS AT WARD LINE PIER HAS ALL HATCHES
SECURED AND UNIDENTIFIED DECK CARGO ON STERN, BOOMS SECURED.

MATANZAS (1617Z) -- TWO KRASNOGRAD-CLASS DRY CARGO SHIPS
REMAIN AT THE NEW WHARF. TWO HATCHES OPEN AND BOOMS SECURED ON
SHIP ON NORTH SIDE OF PIER. SHIP ON SOUTH SIDE HAS ALL HATCHES
CLOSED AND ONE BOOM OVER THE SIDE. TWELVE BOXCARS AND ONE LOCO-
MOTIVE ON PIER BETWEEN SHIPS.

TUNAS DE ZAZA (1639Z) -- KASIMOV REMAINS ANCHORED 1.5 NM SW
OF PORT. FOUR HATCHES ARE OPEN AND BOOMS ARE ACTIVE. FIVE LIGHTERS
AND TWO SMALL CRAFT ARE ALONGSIDE SHIP.

CIENFUEGOS (1630Z) -- TWO TANKERS ARE AT POL PIERS, FOUR
FREIGHTERS PRESENT, ONE DOCKED, THREE ANCHORED IN HARBOR. OKHOTSK

AND KOVROV ARE NOT OBSERVED. SLUTSK CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED.

NUEVITAS (1740Z) -- KHIMIK ZELENSKIY REMAINS TIED UP AT NORTH
SIDE OF PASTELILLO PIER NO 4, SIX HATCHES OPEN. FOURTEEN BOXCARS
AND ONE RAILROAD ENGINE ON DOCK ALONGSIDE SHIP.
