SIDE OF THE MACHINA PIER ON THE WEST SIDE OF HAVANA HARBOR (FRAME

THE FORWARD HATCH APPEARS CLOSED AND AT LEAST THREE BOOMS 25X1
ARE SWUNG OVER THE DOCK. HAZE AND SHADOWS PRECLUDE FURTHER ANALYSIS.
ONE OTHER SPLIT-SUPERSTRUCTURE SHIP IS ANCHORED IN HAVANA HARBOR,
BUT HAZE PERCLUDES IDENTIFICATION.
