THE FOLLOWING IS FROM THE NATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC INTERPRETATION CENTER.

1. PRELIMINARY SCAN OF BRASS KNOB MISSION 3436, DATED 21 FEBRUARY 1963, REVEALS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE PORTS LISTED BELOW:

HAVANA -- THE ORENBURG, KIMOVSK, AND LGOV ARE ANCHORED IN THE HARBOR. THE ORENBURG HAS ONE HATCH OPEN AND A LIGHTER TIED ALONGSIDE. THE KIMOVSK APPEARS TO HAVE TWO HATCHES OPEN, BUT NO OFFLOADING WAS OBSERVED. THE LGOV HAS ALL BOOMS STOWED. THE BAYKAL, WHICH IS REPORTED TO BE IN HAVANA, COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED. [REDACTED]

2. MATANZAS -- THREE FREIGHTERS OBSERVED, INCLUDING 2 KRASNOGRAD-CLASS SHIPS TIED UP AT THE NEW WHARF. THE HATCHES OF ONE KRASNOGRAD-CLASS SHIP APPEAR OPEN AND TWO BOOMS ARE SWUNG OVER THE DOCK. NINE BOXCARS ARE LOCATED ON THE WHARF ALONGSIDE THIS SHIP. [REDACTED]
