 - 2. ORIGINAL NEGATIVE:
- A. THE NEGATIVE IS SLIGHTLY UNDEREXPOSED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MISSION DUE TO THE TIME OF DAY THE PHOTOGRAPHY WAS TAKEN,
 BUT THE EXPOSURE IS ADEQUATE FOR PHOTO INTERPRETATION. THE RESOLUTION IS GOOD.
- B. 9R SIDE: MINOR EMULSION SCRATCHES USUALLY APPEAR ON THE EXPOSURE FOLLOWING A HEAT SPLICE.
- C. 9L SIDE: THERE IS SLIGHT INTERMITTENT EDGE FOG ON BOTH EDGES OF THE FILM THROUGHOUT THE MISSION. A SLIGHT TRACE OF ROLLER STATIC, ALONG THE OUTBOARD EDGE, IS EVIDENT THROUGHOUT THE MISSION. EMULSION SCRATCHES ON FRAMES 657-663 AND 695-703

ARE ROUGHLY PARALLEL TO THE FILM EDGES AND ARE OF ERRATIC LENGTH AND SPACING. SEVERE CREASES APPEAR ON FRAMES 479-483. CREASES OF A LESSER DEGREE APPEAR ON FRAMES 486-488. EDGE CRIMPING OCCURS ON FRAMES 1209-1217. TITLING IS GENERALLY POOR, WITH INK BLOTCHES IN THE FORMAT ON FRAMES 901-907, AND INK TRACKS IN THE BORDER THROUGHOUT THE MISSION.

- D. MINOR PROCESSING STREAKS ARE INTERMITTENT THROUGHOUT THE MISSION.
 - E. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CAMERA OR PROCESSING MALFUNCTIONS.
 - 3. POSITIVE:
- A. PI SUITABILITY IS FAIR. THE POSITIVE IS GROSSLY OVEREXPOSED, RESULTING IN DEGRADED IMAGE QUALITY.
