- 2. ORIGINAL NEGATIVE:
 - A. THE EXPOSURE WAS ADEQUATE AND THE RESOLUTION IS FAIR.
- B. 9L SIDE: INBOARD ROLLER CHATTER IS CONTINUOUS THROUGHOUT
 THE MISSION. OUTBOARD EDGE STATIC AND ASSOCIATED EDGE FOG ARE
 INTERMITTENT THROUGHOUT. MINUS DENSITY DOTS 5.65" FROM THE OUTBOARD
 EDGE APPEAR EACH 1.55" ALONG THE MAJOR AXIS OF THE FILM.
- C. 9R SIDE: NO ANOMALIES, OTHER THAN THOSE DESCRIBED IN ITEM 2D, WERE NOTED ON THIS SIDE OF THE MISSION.
- D. THE FILM METERING IS SLIGHTLY ERRATIC THROUGHOUT THE MISSION. IN SEVERAL INSTANCES THE FILM LEADER WAS NOT TAPED TO THE ROLL BEFORE IT WAS PLACED INTO THE CAN, RESULTING IN DAMAGE TO THE

- E. THE RESOLUTION OF THE PHOTOGRAPHY OBTAINED FROM THIS UNIT IS CONSISTENTLY BELOW THAT OF THE OTHER CAMERAS.
 - F. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CAMERA OR PROCESSING MALFUNCTIONS.
 - 3. POSITIVE:
- A. PI SUITABILITY IS FAIR DUE TO THE DEGRADED RESOLUTION
 OF THE ORIGINAL NEGATIVE. WATER SPOTS WERE CONTINUOUS ALONG THE
 OUTBOARD 25 PERCENT OF THE 9L SIDE.
- B. CLOUDS OBSCURE OR DEGRADE APPROXIMATELY 25 PERCENT OF THIS MISSION.
