RADAR SITE FROM [Redacted] AT 47-54N 38-41E,
4 NAUTICAL MILES NORTH OF TOMAKOVKA, USSR, AND 20 NAUTICAL MILES
WEST OF ZAPOROZHYE. OTHER FACILITIES AT THE SITE INCLUDE AN OCCUPIED
RADAR MOUND WITH FOUR SUPPORTING VANS, AN UNOCCUPIED RADAR MOUND
WITH UNOCCUPIED VAN POSITIONS, AN OCCUPIED NON-ELEVATED RADAR
POSITION, AND ONE SUPPORT BUILDING.
