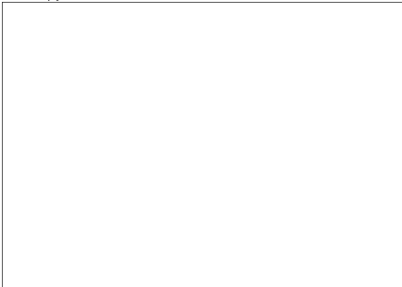

SOVIET SRF PROBABLE REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS FACILITY AT 57-22N/28-18E  
SITUATED AT A MILITARY BARRACKS AREA ON THE NW EDGE OF OSTROV, USSR.  
THIS FACILITY IS SIMILAR TO SIX (6) PREVIOUSLY REPORTED FACILITIES  
IN EUROPEAN USSR (NPIC CABLE 6216, 5 JAN 1966), AND CONSISTS OF AN  
HF COMMUNICATIONS AREA WITH A FISHBONE ANTENNA AND AN ARCH-ROOFED  
CONTROL BUNKER AND A SEPARATE TRIPLE SECTIONED BUNKER AREA.

THIS IS THE ONLY EXAMPLE TO DATE OF THIS TYPE OF FACILITY  
BEING IDENTIFIED AT A MILITARY BARRACKS AREA, THE PREVIOUSLY  
REPORTED SIX HAVING BEEN ISOLATED FROM ANY OTHER ACTIVITY.
