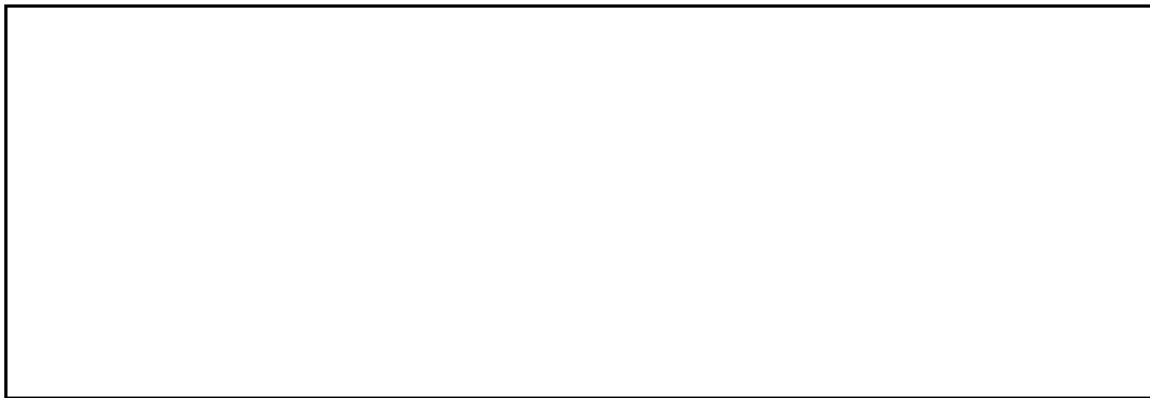

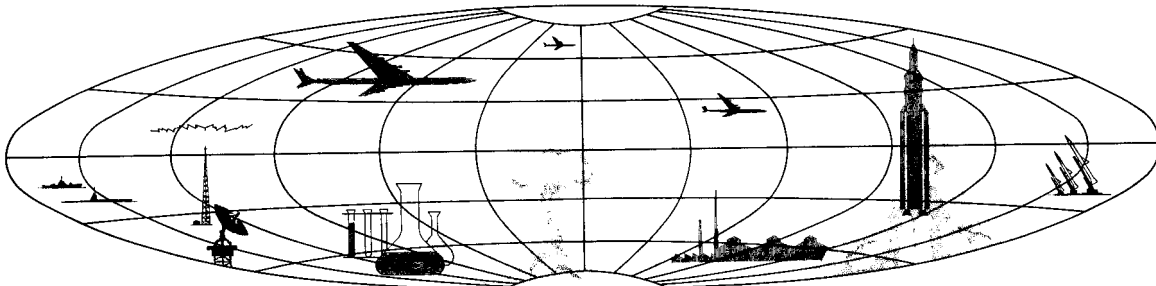

SULECIN ARMY BARRACKS, POLAND

This report is a partial answer to DIA requirement DIA-AP1-63-88, to verify or pinpoint the location of Soviet military garrisons in Poland and to perform a photo analysis to determine boundaries of the installations, to determine function, number, and dimensions of buildings, to estimate troop capacity, and to identify and describe related training areas and facilities and ammunition or POL storage. This report covers a selected installation in the Sulecin area.

[redacted] coverage was not available over this area. Interpretation of available [redacted] photography was limited by scattered clouds and haze, precluding interpretation of some of the facilities.

- square feet of floor space*
- 2 multistory administration buildings, each 170 by 60 feet
- 1 multistory administration building 160 by 60 feet, a total for the three administration buildings of 60,000 square feet of floor space
- 28 one-story storage buildings, each 190 by 50 feet, a total of 266,000 square feet of floor space
- 5 one-story support buildings, each 70 by 25 feet, and
- 2 one-story support buildings, each 50 by 20 feet, a total for the seven support buildings of 10,750 square feet of floor space.

Troop capacity: 4,715*

The Sulecin army barracks and training area located 3.5 miles east of Sulecin cover approximately 3,780 acres, 800 of which are occupied by the army barracks. This installation is both rail and road served and contains:

- 6 multistory barracks, each 170 by 65 feet
- 3 one-story barracks, each 200 by 50 feet
- 8 one-story barracks, each 175 by 35 feet
- 6 one-story barracks, each 115 by 35 feet, a total for the 23 barracks of 235,750

*Troop capacity is computed on a basis of 50 square feet of space per man.

Ammunition Storage

A secured ammunition storage area located 2 miles east of the barracks area covers approximately 14 acres and contains five or six small bunkers of undetermined size. No POL storage is observed.

Training Area

The training area includes a tank firing range, a driver training course, and a probable artillery range. Track activity is observed throughout the training area.

*Floor space of multistory buildings is computed on a basis of two stories unless otherwise specified.
