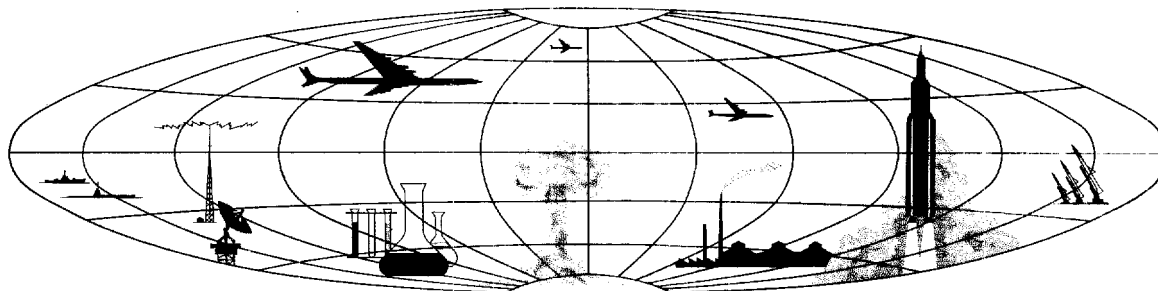

A new type of search radar has been identified in a radar equipment assembly yard in Nanking, China, on [redacted] dated [redacted] [redacted] The assembly yard is located just east of the Nan Ching Army Supply Depot Hsuan Wu Hu Northwest [redacted] within the city limits of Nanking.

The radar consists of a trailer base with two outriggers and a heavy, dense probable mattress-type sail with preliminary measurements of approximately 20 feet wide by 35 feet high. The trailer base resembles the base utilized by the SCR-270A radar. The sail does not resemble any previously known mattress-type sails. The radar was
