



SUMMARY




FIGURE 2. UZHGOROD ARMY BARRACKS SOUTHWEST, USSR

This small army barracks is located in the southwest sector of Uzhgorodimmediately south of the cemetery (Figure 1). It is a relatively new installation; most of the construction was It contains eight done after multistory barracks buildings, four multistory administrative buildings, a motor pool, and miscellaneous small administrative and storage buildings (Figures 2 and 3). # DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

#### Road Service

The installation has access to Uzhgorod city streets.

### Administrative and Troop Housing Areas

Area D1 contains ten 40- by 20-foot single story probable BOQ or NCO quarters and four 50- by 50-foot single story administrative buildings.

Area D2 contains eight multistory 150- by 50-foot permanent masonry troop barracks and four multistory permanent masonry 200- by 50-foot administrative buildings.

## Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains one 500- by 200-foot motor pool, one single story 150- by 35-foot vehicle storage building, and three single story 50- by 50-foot vehicle maintenance buildings.
