B. CUSTOM PROCESSING

THE FACTORY REPRESENTATIVE WILL ALSO SUBMIT SAMPLES OF DUPLICATE MATERIALS WHICH ARE NOW WITHIN HIS CAPABILITY AND FROM WHICH CUSTOMERS COULD SELECT THE TYPE OF PROCESSING MOST USEFUL TO EACH RECEIVING AGENCY . AT THIS TIME NO FURTHER VARIATIONS ARE FEASIBLE. IT WILL HAVE TO BE RECOGNIZED THAT IF IT IS CONSIDERED IMPORTANT BY THE CUSTOMERS TO HAVE THEIR DUPLICATE MATERIALS PROCESSED DIFFERENT ONE FROM ANOTHER SOME DELAY WILL HAVE TO BE INCURRED.

TO INFO CITE

HAS ARRIVED AT THE FACTORY WHICH TOGETHER IN EFFECT PRODUCE A FEELING OF TIME LIMITATION ON HIS PART. IT APPEARS TO BE NECESSARY FOR THE COMMUNITY TO BECOME RE-EDUCATED TO BE MORE PATIENT AND K TO RELIEVE THESE PRESSURES IN ORDER THAT THE FACTORY CAN PRODUCE WHAT IS NEEDED. 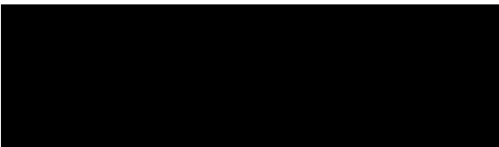

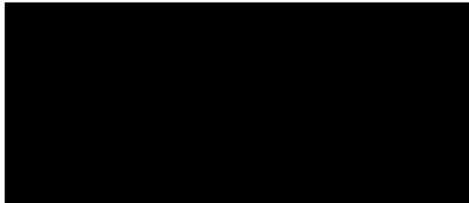
