1. Spectrazonal Photography. [redacted] had some very striking color prints made from the black and white spectrazonal negatives. Small almost invisible grey scale differences on a comparable black and white negative showed up glaringly as widely disparate colors on the color print. I asked them to send some of those prints to you on an urgent basis which they said they would.. This is material prepared since Earl's last visit.

5. Automatic registration of stereo images. The breadboard is not quite ready for demonstration. This is a Company financed development. Two cathode ray tubes scan the stereo pair of photos. The electronics changes the image shapes and brings the images into registration and displays them on two monitor tubes each of which is presented to an observers eye. They expect this can be done while the film is passing under the CRT's at a normal scanning rate. I suggested they send the Staff a
