1. The request contained in the reference letter has been discussed with [REDACTED], Procurement Division, Office of Logistics, and [REDACTED], Security Branch, Support Staff. As a result of this coordination, it has been determined that no change in the wording of the security paragraph in the subject contract is required. The present wording permits the assignment of a higher classification, to certain documents, at the discretion of the technical representative.

2. As a matter of practicality, since [REDACTED] is intimately involved in the review of the various [REDACTED] reports, it is proposed that [REDACTED] assume the responsibility for the assignment of appropriate classification to all documents above the secret level and that he also assume the responsibility for insuring that the appropriate established controls are applied in the handling of all such documents.

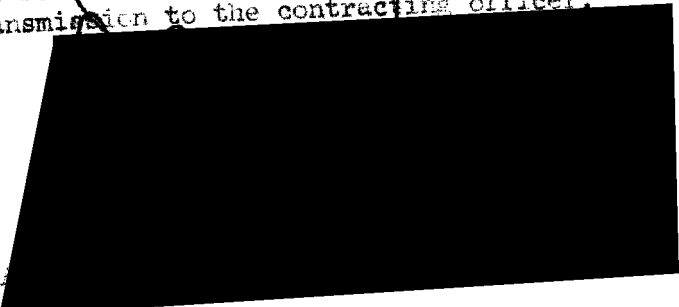

3. It is understood that the addition of code word material and the writing, typing, and reproduction of all documentation containing such material, will be performed within the confines of NPIC.

4. A memo has been forwarded to the Office of Logistics requesting a change in contractual wording to permit the submission of the contracting officer's copies of all reports, from NPIC, instead of [REDACTED] directly from the contractor. It will be necessary to sanitize two (2) copies of all reports to the secret level and forward these copies to the technical officer for transmission to the contracting officer.

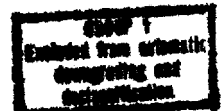

SUBJECT: Required Change in Basic Contract No. [REDACTED] T.O. 14 25X1A

Request that the first paragraph under the heading "SECURITY" on page 3 of the subject contract be amended to read:

"The reports to be delivered hereunder may be classified TOP SECRET and handled in special control systems."

Delivery instructions should be modified accordingly. Conversations with contractor personnel on 11 May 1966 concerning the forthcoming report on NPIC Review and functional Flow Diagrams made it obvious that the above amendment is essential if the report is truly to reflect the Center's functional flow. Serious consideration was given to the possibility of producing a basic report at the SECRET level, and a TOP SECRET controlled supplement to the basic report. It was concluded that such a procedure would in effect render both reports meaningless and of significantly less value to NPIC.
