1. Request that the area at [REDACTED] which is currently cleared for TOP SECRET, be cleared for handling materials within the TALENT-KEYHOLE control system. It is further requested that the action required to establish this clearance level be expedited so that such clearance can be established prior to 1 June 1966.

2. Initially, it was felt that materials needed at the [REDACTED] facility could be sanitized to the TOP SECRET level. However, experience has shown that, when the codeword information is stripped from the materials, [REDACTED] level and often bear little resemblance to the materials actually handled in NPIC. This has resulted in an awkward working relationship on the referenced contract, and has necessitated an undue amount of commuting to the Washington area by members of the [REDACTED] systems analysis team. It should be noted that the cost of such commuting, as well as the time wasted in commuting, is at the expense of the U.S. Government.

3. Serious consideration was given to modification of the contract to require that all work be done within NPIC. This proved to be unrealistic, since the contractor is not able to relocate the personnel assigned to the systems analysis team. Even if such a move were practical personnel-wise, it would result in a significant increase in cost to the government at a time when every effort is being made to hold costs down.

4. It should be noted that courier runs to a codeword facility at [REDACTED] would be on an ad hoc basis, and would not exceed one run per week. NPIC will provide such courier service.
