
Gentlemen:

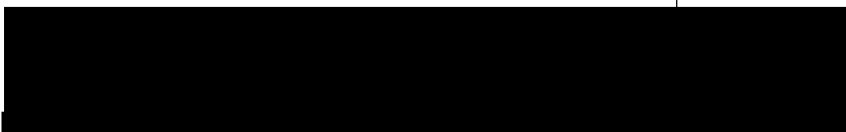
