The Chairman opened the meeting by stating that his association with this committee of professionals has been a distinguished pleasure. In his opinion the guidance and coordination of the J-3 tests with the intelligence community was essential to the timely accomplishments of the J-3 test program. In some areas, such as color, a paucity of information precludes final judgement of its future. A draft copy of the proposed covering memorandum that will forward the summary report to the DNRO was circulated for review.
