tions at the close of contract efforts on 22 July 1966.

It is recommended that the Contracting Officer or his representative
visit [redacted] to inspect the photographic laboratory equipment at an early
date.

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Applicable costs for dismantling, packing and shipping the equipment
are not included in the present contract price. These costs can be
