MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: [Redacted]

On 22 March 1965 [Redacted] Technical Representative for [Redacted] discussed the negative marking problem, and its relationship to the printer, with [Redacted] Assistant for Operations, NPIC. [Redacted] stated that no marks or codes of any manner or material would be placed on the original negative other than those resulting from the acquisition and processing phases. [Redacted] is aware of the fact that the lack of marks on the negative would greatly reduce the automatic features of the printer. He suggested the use of edge sensors and footage counters -- these will be investigated as stated in the basic memorandum.
