MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Logistics Branch, SS/NPIC

SUBJECT : Amendment of Contract [redacted]

1. It is requested that your office prepare a requisition to amend the subject contract with the [redacted] without additional cost to the Government. Under the terms of Task I, Article II, List of Firms which provides for the addition or deletion to the list of firms by the Contracting Officer you are requested to add [redacted]

[redacted] This action is to cover travel at the request of the Technical Representative of the Contracting Officer to the [redacted] on 3 September 1964.

2. While this action is not in keeping with either the spirit or the intent of the contractual arrangement of the [redacted] [redacted] has informed me this date, that this action is necessary. The original intent of our relationship with the [redacted] was to add or delete companies to Article II as simply and expeditiously as possible, often the same day that an emergency occurs. [redacted] has been informed of our dissatisfaction with the present arrangement specified by the contract and will endeavor to find adequate procedures through contract amendment or administrative decision which will allow timely action by [redacted] and thereby obviate the necessity for NPIC monitors making emergency trips to West Coast companies.
