Article on Photo Interpretation for Forthcoming Issue
of OTR Publication Studies in Intelligence

1. Attached hereto is the rough draft of a manuscript which I have titled "Consider the Mata Hari with Glass Eyes." As I discussed with you during our last telephone conversation the purpose of this article is to cover the early development of photo intelligence up to World War II. Hopefully in some later issue of Studies in Intelligence another article would follow as Part 2 which would carry the story of the development of photo intelligence from World War II up to the present time. Also as we discussed it we would look forward to separate, shorter articles by appropriate specialists on the uses of photo interpretation for such purposes as technical intelligence, strategic intelligence, protection against surprise attack, economic intelligence, geographic intelligence, and so forth.

2. I hope by this means that the door may be left wide open for as many additional views on this subject as OTR would like to carry in its studies and thereby support Sherman Kent's view that we should not try to write something in the first instance that would be so comprehensive that others would feel left out.

3. Please consider this manuscript as a rough draft and do with it as you will. I have no pride of authorship and you may rewrite, eliminate, reorganize or do whatever else you think necessary to cast this in the right form to be useful and attractive to the readers of Studies in Intelligence.
