3. Executive Council Meeting Notes

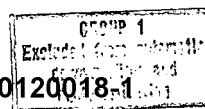
Mr. Lundahl reported on items of interest from the Executive Council Meeting of 22 May. The meeting for 19 May was cancelled. Of particular note were the following:
