

8. Stoertz Luncheon

Friday (15 May 1970)

JJH had lunch with Stoertz today in the Green Room. The following items were discussed:

a. Chinese Petroleum Refinery - JJH told Stoertz of IEG's plans to publish a PIM on the Chinese Petroleum Refinery recently found by [redacted] [redacted] Stoertz had no objections to this since this was not third-phase reporting.

b. MIS - JJH told Stoertz that he is reviewing the utility of the MIS. He asked if Stoertz would be willing to show him how IAS uses the data from this system. Stoertz said that he would be happy to; that he does find the MIS useful; and that they have learned to work around some of the lack of timeliness of the data through some hand-kept records within IAS. JJH assured Stoertz that he would not make any basic

c. Building Space Problems - JJH told Stoertz about the current review of building space and the decision to move the Map Library and reduce it in size. Stoertz reminded JJH that starting this FY he will have a requirement for additional space for IAS. This matter was not discussed.

d. Light Tables/Rhomboids - The NPIC decision to buy the [redacted] Light tables and the Mod 28 Rhomboids was discussed. The fact that we are awaiting OPPB financing before requisitioning this equipment was mentioned by JJH.

e. [redacted] Visit - JJH told Stoertz that he would be touring [redacted] this coming Monday.

f. ACL/RJS Lunch with [redacted] - JJH told Stoertz that it appears that PNS will be extending as the Deputy Director, NPIC, and that Col. [redacted] will be the new Deputy Chief, IEG.

g. [redacted] Return - JJH told Stoertz that [redacted] is scheduled to EOD in NPIC on 21 July. He told him that there will be a one-week overlap with [redacted]

h. JJH Leave - JJH told Stoertz that he will be on leave next Thursday and Friday - no lunch with Stoertz next week.

i. IAS Maintenance Support - Stoertz answered the JJH query of the last luncheon meeting concerning the level of maintenance support which IAS will require of TSSG/ESD. Stoertz stated that he would like to have [redacted] be in touch with [redacted] to discuss this support (JJH plans to talk to [redacted] next week).

j. IAS Assessments - Stoertz stated that he had just become aware that NPIC was not receiving IAS assessments of GIANT SCALE missions. He stated that he would send those to [redacted] restricting distribution to just [redacted] because of CIA sensitive type items included.
