SUBJECT : Request for Exception to Current Entrance On Duty Policy

1. This memorandum contains in paragraph 3 a recommendation for your approval.
2. We have been advised of the on duty strength status of the Agency which has prompted the current freeze on EOD's. The circumstances necessitating this action are understood; however, the following case appears to warrant consideration for exception to the policy:

[redacted] is of prime concern to us for two reasons: (1) She is an academically-qualified individual in a shortage field for which travel benefits are authorized. [redacted] obtained a B.A. degree in English from the University of Miami in August 1967 and a Master's Degree in Library Science from the Catholic University of America in January 1969. We currently have two vacancies in the Library, and [redacted] is one of three applicants in process. (2) She has been in process for the Librarian position since April 1969. Because of her original availability date, a 60-day priority clearance was requested. Final clearances, medical and security, were not obtained until February 1970. During this lengthy waiting period, [redacted] accompanied her parents on their overseas assignment and maintained her high interest in employment with CIA. Because she was overseas and because of the complications of the processing, we did not press for an office interview until we were certain that security and medical clearances would be granted. Having been advised of the clearances, [redacted] was notified that an office interview would be necessary but that the cost of her travel for the interview would have to be borne by her. [redacted] returned from overseas at her own expense for the interview, and the very favorable impression she made strengthened our interest in employing her. Miss [redacted] is now in Washington, unemployed, and we believe that further delay of her EOD will create serious problems for her and jeopardize our opportunity to hire her.
