1. In response to your memo and that of [redacted] I talked to [redacted] on 23 January 1970. 25X1

2. I told [redacted] that I was undertaking to determine what was involved in changing the status of personnel with reserve appointments to Agency career service appointments. I am doing so by requesting that such a change be made for one of NPIC's reserve appointment officers [redacted] when that action is completed, we shall understand better what is involved, and can then consider acting on other reserve appointment cases. 25X1

3. I told [redacted] that he was considered by you and by me as an officer of high value, and that he should not be concerned about the security of his employment with NPIC. I recommended that he renew his reserve appointment for five years, and indicated that this would not, in my view, affect an earlier consideration of changing his status to a career appointment. 25X1

4. I want you and [redacted] to process the renewal of [redacted] reserve appointment. 25X1
