



SUBJECT: Briefing at NPIC

In connection with a consideration of verification aspects for possible arms control agreements in both the SALT and MBFR areas, it would be extremely useful if some of our ACDA officers could become more familiar with the source materials, analysis procedures, and products of the National Photographic Interpretation Center (NPIC).

I would greatly appreciate it, therefore, if a series of briefings at NPIC could be arranged for this purpose in the immediate future. The subject areas which appear to us to be most useful would be:

- 1. a general orientation briefing concerning the types of photographs used and their exploitation;
- 2. strategic target interpretation, including demonstration of some of the NPIC models of these targets;
- 3. interpretation of tactical forces, installations, and equipment:
- 4. an informal discussion of future imagery exploitation possibilities and problems.

Perhaps these subjects should be covered in separate sessions, in order that attendance can be limited to those ACDA personnel with a need-to-know in each case.
