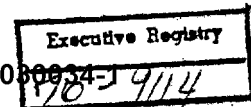


Subject: OMB Circular A-109, Major System Acquisitions

The subject Circular was distributed on April 6, 1976, following the 30-day congressional review required by Public Law 93-400. We have begun to schedule meetings with agency representatives to discuss implementation plans. We are looking forward to working closely with your representatives during the next six months as your action plan for implementation is developed.

With respect to congressional response to the Circular, Congressman Jack Brooks, Chairman of the House Committee on Government Operations, stated:

"The thrust of the Circular is very constructive and appears to cover the major aspects of the issue."
