SUBJECT: Port Studies, Hon Gay and Cam Pha, North Vietnam

REFERENCES: (a) Requirement No. C-RR6-83,897

1. In response to the above referenced requirement dated 12 August 1966, a study was made of the North Vietnamese Ports of Cam Pha and Hon Gay to locate and identify those civilian structures which are near the wharves and coal processing facilities.

<u>Area Number</u>	<u>Number and description of buildings</u>
1	Dock area, 10 small one-story sheds, probably for equipment storage and light repairs
2	Possible coke and steel plant, and small coal screening building, 9 long one-story buildings, 7 smaller associated buildings
3	Possible dock administration buildings, 4 one-story probable office buildings
4	Offices, this group of nine single-story buildings contains the Post and Customs offices and a substation. There are also 17 smaller buildings which may be associated with the offices or may be small dwellings.
5	Residential, 8 single family unit dwellings.
6	Residential, approximately 20 small huts
7	Residential, approximately 10 small huts
8	Residential, 4 houses, 10 small huts
9	Storage, 2 long single story, probable rail associated warehouses
10	Offices, 2 single-story buildings
11	Mine offices and hospital, 2 large two to three story buildings, 7 smaller single-story buildings.
12	Residential, approximately 50 small huts and 5 larger houses
13	Possible church or temple and two associated smaller buildings
14	Warehouse area and open storage, 7 large warehouses and 10 smaller sheds
15	Railroad shops and possible warehouses, 5 long high roof buildings, 10 smaller associated single story buildings and sheds
