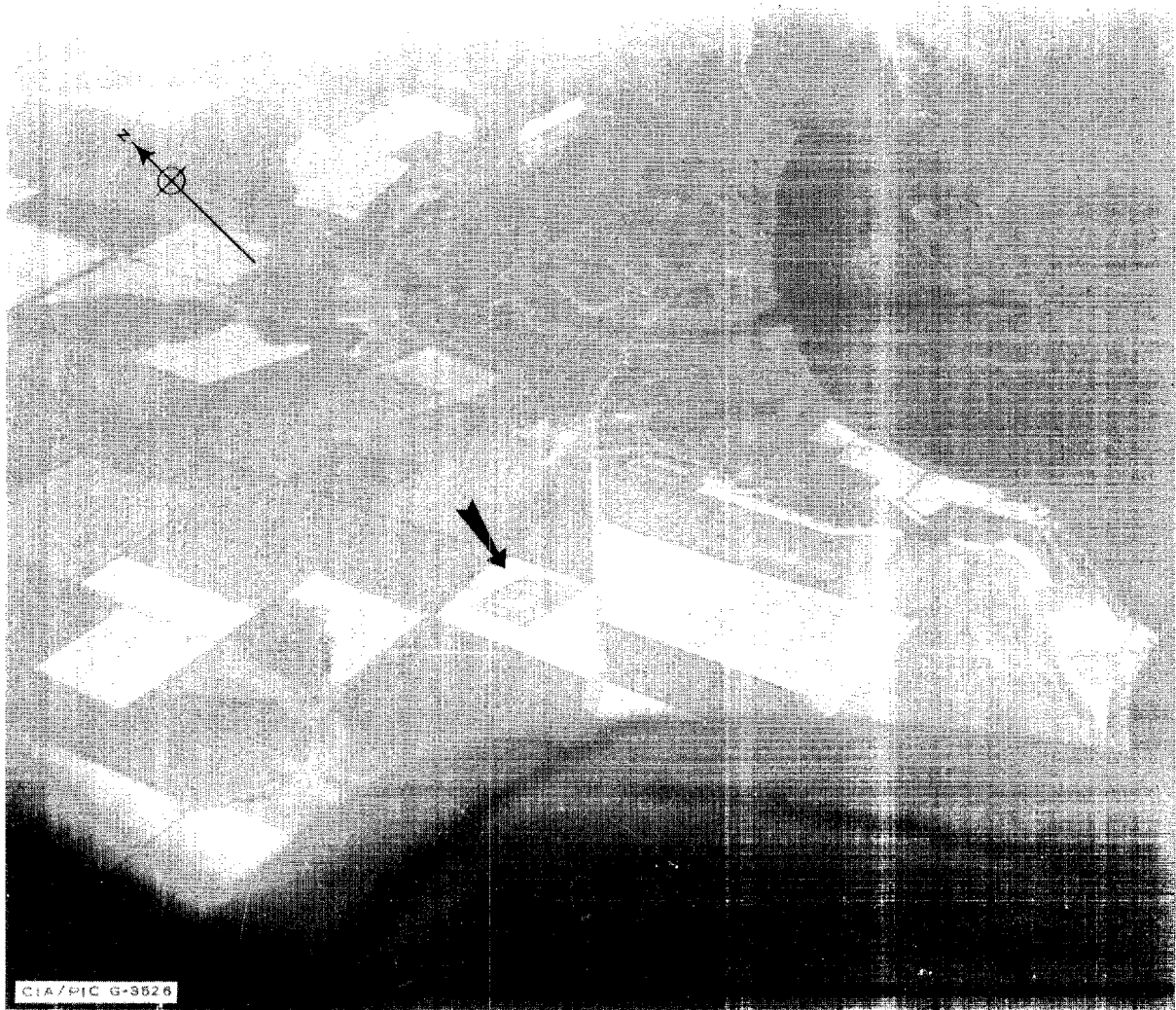


Figure 1 SAM SITE 15 NM SSW OF ZAPOROZHYE NEAR BELENKOYE

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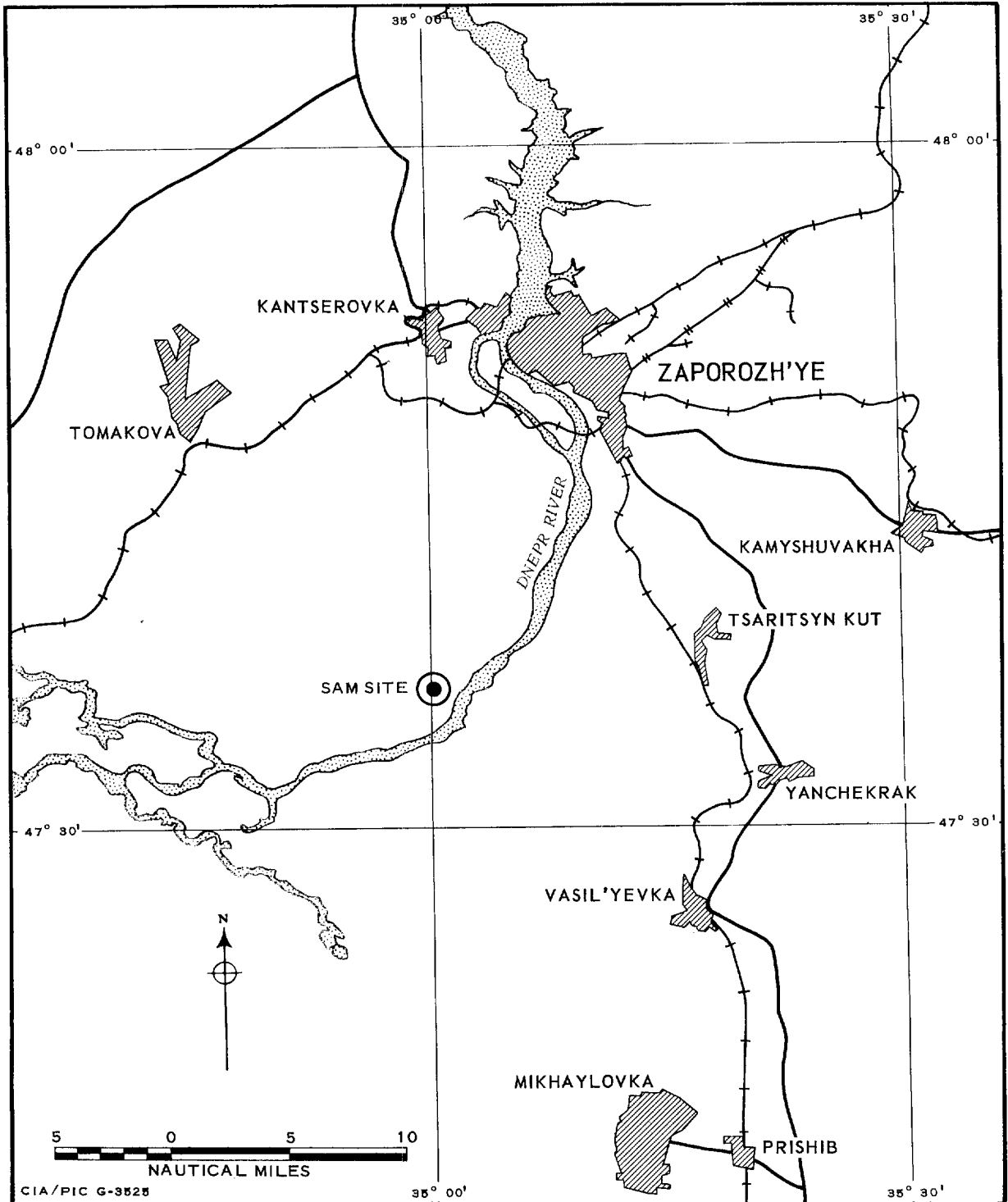


FIGURE 2. SAM SITE 15 NM SSW OF ZAPOROZH'YE, NEAR BELENKOYE
