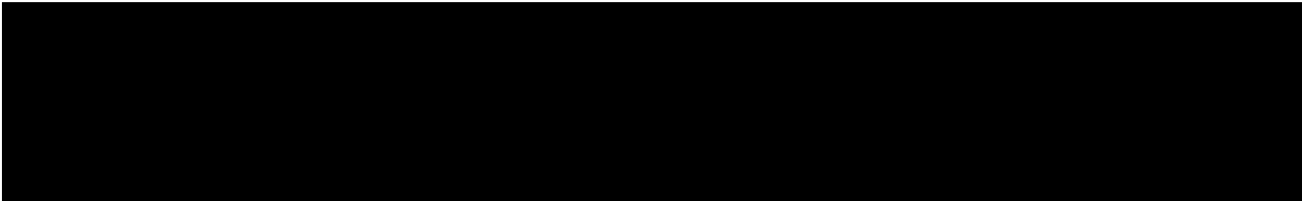

REMARKS

Shalya (57-15N 58-43E) is 77 miles west of Sverdlovsk on the Trans-Siberian Railroad (Route 410)*. As shown on the accompanying line drawing, rail facilities at Shalya include the following:

- Rail yard eight or nine tracks wide, 4,500 feet long
- Rail yard five or six tracks wide, 4,500 feet long
- Car repair shop 160 by 45 feet, one track entering
- Locomotive repair shop 150 by 50 feet, two tracks entering
- Turning wye, effective length 350 feet
- Coal storage yard 1,145 by 145 feet, served by one track
- Passenger station 160 by 45 feet, with a covered platform 710 feet long

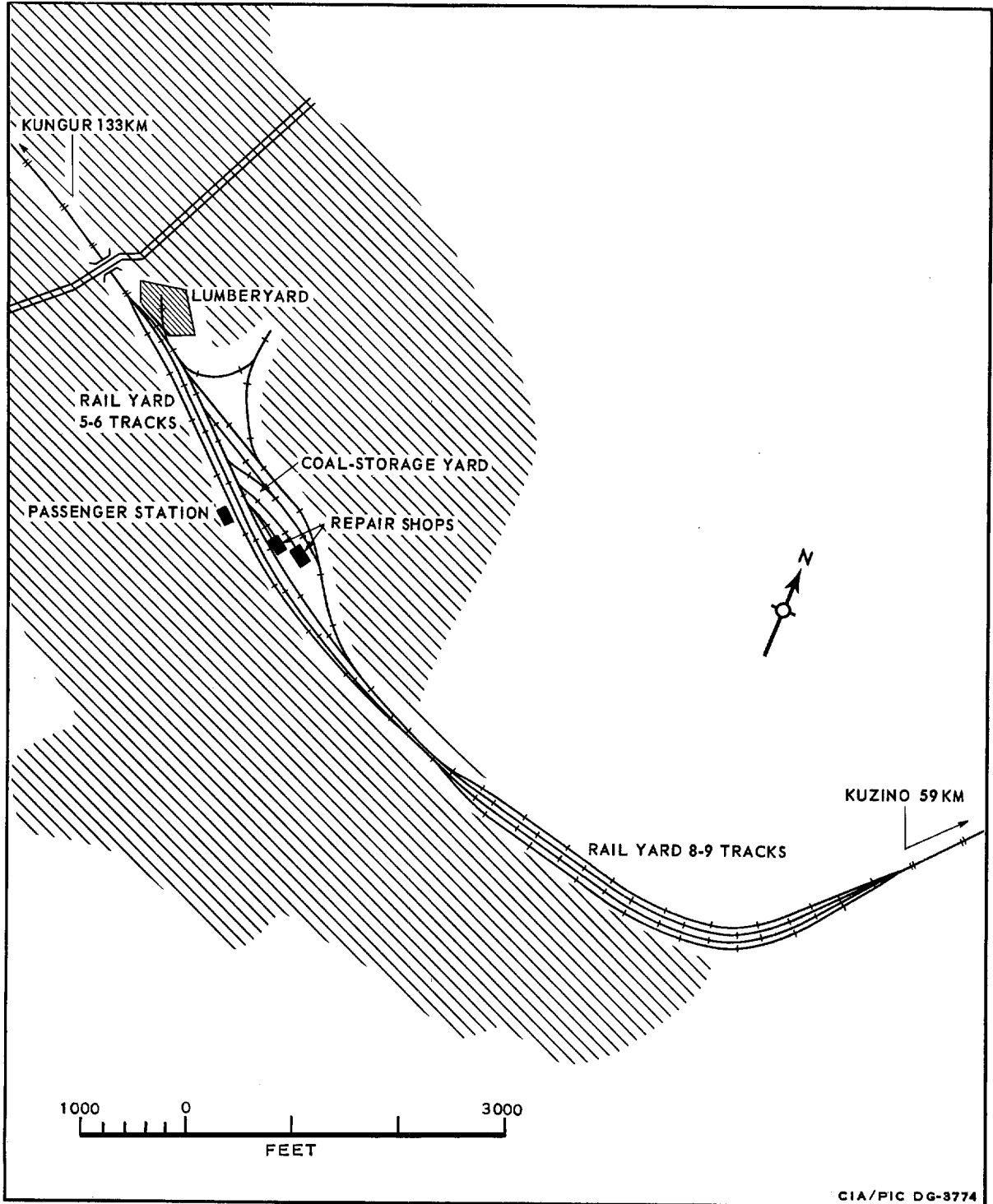
