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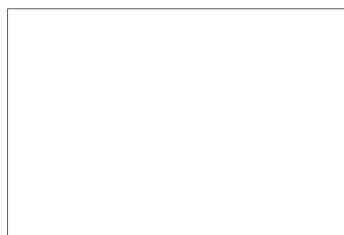

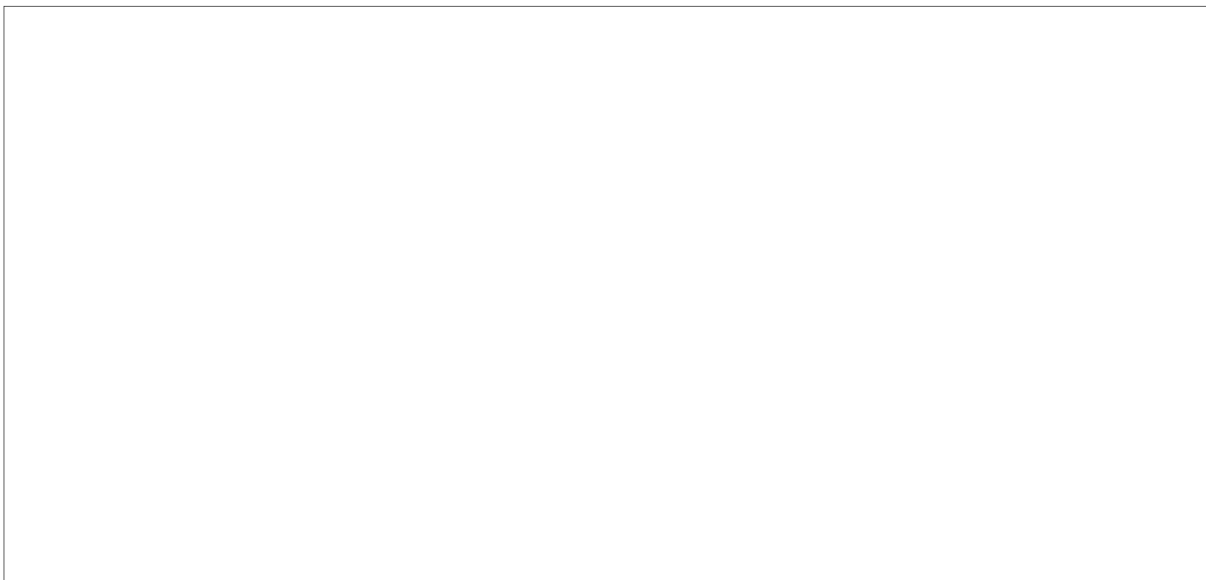

REMARKS:

ON 12 DEC THE SCT-1 FIRST- AND SECOND-STAGE TRANSPORTERS WERE PARKED NEAR PAD B2. THE GANTRY WAS OVER THE B2 LAUNCH STAND, OBSCURING A POSSIBLE MISSILE ON THE LAUNCH STAND. THE ARMS OF THE SERVICE TOWER WERE IN THE OPEN, RETRACTED POSITION. TWO ROWS OF PROPAGANDA PLACARDS HAD BEEN ALIGNED ALONGSIDE PAD B2 BETWEEN 8 AND 12 DEC.

THE LARGE GANTRY WAS BESIDE THE EMPTY B2 LAUNCH STAND ON 28 OCT, 1 AND 6 NOV, AND 8 DEC. ON 11, 24, AND 29 NOV AND 3 AND 12 DEC THE GANTRY WAS OVER THE LAUNCH STAND.

NEW EFFLUENT APPEARED IN THE B2 SUMP TWICE DURING THIS MISSION, BETWEEN 28 OCT AND 1 NOV AND BETWEEN 3 AND 8 DEC.

REMARKS:

NO EQUIPMENT OR ACTIVITY WAS APPARENT ON PADS A1 OR A3 ON THE NINE DAYS THIS COMPLEX WAS COVERED BETWEEN 28 OCT AND 12 DEC. SEVEN ELECTRONICS VANS AND THREE SIMILAR BUT SLIGHTLY LARGER VEHICLES WERE ALIGNED ACROSS PAD A2 ON 8 AND 12 DEC. THE VEHICLE AND TRACK ACTIVITY EAST OF THE CHECKOUT AREA, FIRST OBSERVED IN MAR 72 ([Redacted]) CONTINUED THROUGH 11 NOV. ON PHOTOGRAPHY OF 24 NOV AND LATER, NO VEHICLES OR ACTIVITY WERE APPARENT IN THIS AREA.

A NEW CENTER LINE HAS BEEN PAINTED ON THE MAIN RUNWAY. SEVEN BUILDINGS WERE UNDER CONSTRUCTION NEAR THE WEATHER STATION. FIVE LARGE AND 18 SMALL HORIZONTAL POL TANKS (NOT INSTALLED) WERE IN THE POL SUPPORT AREA.

SUPPORT FACILITIES INCLUDE THREE HANGARS, A MAIN CONTROL TOWER ON TOP OF THE OLD TERMINAL BUILDING, AN ALTERNATE CONTROL TOWER AT EACH END OF THE MAIN RUNWAY, A NEW TERMINAL BUILDING, SEVEN AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE BUILDINGS, 42 BARRACKS, SIX MESSHALLS (ONE UNDER CONSTRUCTION), 16 ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, 57 SUPPORT BUILDINGS, 19 STORAGE BUILDINGS, TEN VEHICLE MAINTENANCE/STORAGE BUILDINGS, TWO AUDITORIUMS, A POL STORAGE AREA, A PROBABLE AMMUNITION STORAGE AREA, AND A RAIL SPUR CONNECTING THE POL STORAGE AREA AND THE HANGAR AREA.

THE POL STORAGE AREA, 1 NM NW OF THE CENTER OF THE RUNWAY (RP), HAS THREE RAIL-LOADING AREAS, FIVE PUMPHOUSES, 12 POL BUNKERS, SIX EARTH-MOUNDED TANKS, TWO VERTICAL POL TANKS, 30 SMALL HORIZONTAL POL TANKS (NOT INSTALLED), SIX BARRACKS/QUARTERS, AND 12 STORAGE/SUPPORT BUILDINGS.

THE PROBABLE AMMUNITION STORAGE AREA, APPROXIMATELY 3 NM NW OF THE RP IN A HILLY REGION, CONSISTS OF NINE REVETTED AMMUNITION STORAGE BUILDINGS, TWO AMMUNITION STORAGE BUILDINGS, FOUR STORAGE BUILDINGS, AND SEVERAL ADITS. AN EXTENSIVE MINING OPERATION IS INTERMINGLED WITH THE STORAGE AREA AND MAY USE SOME OF THE BUILDINGS FOR EXPLOSIVES STORAGE.

A SIX-POSITION AAA SITE IS SE OF THE RP AND ADJACENT TO THE MAIN RUNWAY. ONE BARRACKS AND SIX SUPPORT BUILDINGS WERE OBSERVED AT THE SITE.

ON [REDACTED] F-9 AIRCRAFT WERE OBSERVED DEPLOYED FOR THE FIRST 25X1 TIME AT THE AIRFIELD. TWELVE DERELICT FUSELAGES AND SEVERAL SMALL CRATES AND PIECES OF EQUIPMENT WERE SCATTERED THROUGHOUT

A SHED WAS UNDER CONSTRUCTION OVER THE SECOND REPAIRWAY. APPROXIMATELY 75 CONCRETE OBJECTS WERE IN AN OPEN STORAGE AREA. SEVERAL PROBABLE FLOTATION DEVICES WERE LYING ON THE MUD FLATS AROUND THE PIERS.

A PROBABLE R SS WAS MOORED AT ONE OF THE FINGER PIERS ON 4 DEC 72. THIS IS THE FIRST IDENTIFICATION OF A SUBMARINE AT THIS FACILITY. IT IS ALSO THE FIRST IDENTIFICATION OF THE HUTUNG ASR AT THIS FACILITY.
